

## Dear participant,

First of all, we want to give you a warm welcome to the Dutch Junior Open 2023. Your journey to enjoy squash as its most starts officially here. We hope you had a safe trip to the hotel and your check-in went smoothly. This letter will give you all the extra information you need to be fully prepared for your stay in Amsterdam.

We're happy that you're finally able to compete on an international level again after two years full of challenges. You've already received the player's manual containing all the relevant information about the tournament. This document can be found at www.djosquash.nl

You're staying in the 'van der Valk Hotel' near Schiphol Airport. The 'Valk hotel' will serve daily breakfast in the restaurant from 5 am till 11 am. If you've ordered a food package, lunch and dinner will be served at the Frans Otten Stadium; see the floor plan in the players manual for the exact location. The transfer shuttle to the venue will depart at the back of the hotel. Please don't hop in the shuttles on the front side of the 'Valk hotel'. They will bring you back to the Schiphol Terminals. On Wednesday from 2 pm till 8 pm) and Thursday morning (7:15 am till 11:00 am), there will be a liaison of the tournament present to help you out with questions concerning your stay near the reception area; please ask the reception for more information (Tel: '9').

During your stay, we have some basic principles to make it an unforgettable event for everyone, as well as some information that is good to have in mind:

- In The Netherlands, you're obliged to have a Passport/ID Card with you at all times;
- Alcoholic consumption in The Netherlands is permitted from the age of 18 years old; when you're in competition, you're not allowed to drink any alcoholic consumptions;
- The tournament follows the rules of the Dutch Doping Authority, licensed via WADA;
- Please avoid disturbance to other guests in any form;
- In your hotel, it's prohibited to smoke and to take towels from the hotel to the venue;
- The WI-FI in the hotel is free of charge;
- You love a clean place, so as we do, so please clean up your mess;
- After your own match, you are obliged to referee the game right after your own match on the same court together with your opponent;
- An information desk is located at Frans Otten Stadium near the tournament desk;
- All fixtures, matches and court allocations are real-time shown on the TV screens near the tournament desk:
- Be polite to your fellow participants, coaches, people in/around the club, event crew and everyone involved; we're all here with the best intentions.
