DUTCH JUNIOR OPEN 2026

Hereby we send you the invitation form of the Dutch Junior Open 2026 in Amsterdam. The following guidelines apply for entering the tournament:

- All categories have a maximum draw of 128 players. Restrictions will be made according to ESF Guidelines.
- The event status is a ESF Juniors GOLD event and is part of the ESF Junior Circuit.
- Entries can only be made by the Individuals and Member National Associations. Entries from countries not associated with the ESF will have to provide a contact person from the Official Federation. This person must take responsibility for all entries from that country.
- All players will stay at the tournament Hotel: Van der Valk Schiphol or The Olympic Hotel Amsterdam
- All players must wear approved eye guards.
- The recording of matches for coaching / performance analysis purposes is acceptable provided the player and / or their parents / coaches do not object.
- Players can use the swimming pool and fitness facilities in the hotel only under strict adult supervision.
- The organization retains the right to have the possibility to divide players into 3- or 4-person bedrooms if necessary
- **Individual entries will only be accepted using the online entry at esf.tournamentsoftware.com > Dutch Junior Open 2026**
- **An entry is only accepted when payment has been made.**
- **Closing date is the 5th of April 2026 for all packages.**
- As specified by the European Squash Federation; to compete in all ESF registered events, all players, coaches, managers and other officials must be registered with ESF. This must be approved and validated by the relevant MNF. The MNF is responsible for ensuring that all players, coaches, managers and other officials are registered with ESF prior to entry, and their entry is fully supported. - **Coaches:** All team or individual player coaches designated by their Nation as part of their event onsite management team(solely or in attendance with an appointed team manager)at any Championship held under the auspices of ESF must be ESF registered, i.e. have an ESID, as their licence to attend as a formal representative. This is required at the time of them being registered to attend by their National federation.

The tournament will start promptly at 09.00 hrs. on Thursday, 2nd July and all participants must be available at the venue at this time.

Thursday 2nd July - Sunday 5th July 2026. The tournament will commence Thursday 09.00 hours. All participants must be available at the venue from this time.

The event complies with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website

– www.europeansquash.com – all participating MNAs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

Players may only enter **one** category. A minimum of three matches will be scheduled. All players are guaranteed a minimum of three matches. The U11 categories are not recognized for ranking purposes of ESF. The U11 can't complain about any seeding.

ELIGIBILITY

The Dutch Junior Open is open to all players under the age of 11, 13, 15, 17 or 19 on 5th July 2026, as appropriate.

SEEDING

The seeding will be undertaken using the ESF Junior Rankings valid at the closing date for entries and in accordance with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines. Also the results of the latest tournament will be used. The top 8 seeds in each category will be determined. Any non-European players who do not have an ESF ranking will be seeded by the Tournament Director. Details of the seeding will be found at the 25th of June on the tournament website (www.djosquash.nl). The tournament will commence Thursday 09.00 hours. All participants must be available at the venue from this time.

MATCHES

All matches will be played as best of five games, under the rules of the WSF. Scoring will be PAR 11 to 2 clear points.

REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches after their match.

BALL

The Dunlop Pro ball will be used.

TOURNAMENT PRIZE MONEY

There will be price money in the under 19 Boys/Girls categories. Trophies will be awarded in all categories.

EYE GUARDS

All junior players (under 19 years of age) must wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play. The list of WSF Certified Eyewear allowable at the time of participation can be viewed on the WSF website.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organizers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance.

ENTRIES

There are two ways of entering the Dutch Junior Open:

- **Individual entries** ○ Individual entries will only be accepted using the online entry of tournamentsoftware.com www.djosquash.nl -> Online Entry
- **Entering trough a National Federation (MNA, Association)** ○ Entries trough a National Federation will only be accepted using the online entry for Nations at tournamentsoftware.com www.djosquash.nl -> Online Entry (MNA OR LARGE GROUPS ONLY)

Individual entries will only be accepted using the online entry www.djosquash.nl -> Online entry. MNA & Group large group entries can use a different form via djosquash.nl or events@squashbond.nl

All entries must provide a contact person from the official federation. The named responsible person must be an official representative of the MNA. This person must take responsibility for all entries from that country. The organization can restrict entries according to ESF guidelines.

Only Federations (MNA's) or large groups (minimum of 6) can enter a group via djo@squashbond.nl

Safeguarding, health and safety

Adults interacting with juniors in the organization and running of ESF Junior Circuit events are in a position of trust and influence. They should always ensure that junior players are treated fairly, with respect, and given suitable support. Tournaments should be run in a safe, positive and encouraging environment. The host Organizing Committee, including Tournament Director and Tournament Referee should be trained in safeguarding children according to the host MNF national standards. The health and safety of all persons (players, officials, spectators, tournament staff) involved in or attending a tournament is of paramount importance. The Organizing Committee, via the host MNF is responsible for ensuring an appropriate plan is in place for the tournament.

ESF Regulations & Penalties

The tournament is part of the ESF Junior Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com. MNFs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements. The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in ESF Regulations: Code of Conduct. The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in EUROPEAN SQUASH FEDERATION PRIVACY POLICY as published on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com. A late withdrawal is a withdrawal made 2 days or less before the start date of the tournament. Ranking penalties may be applied to the records of the players who fail to turn up or who make a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate. Please note: The medical certificate must clearly state the players name, date of birth and nature of the illness/injury the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF Office within 2 days after the final day of the tournament.

If a player:

- a) Has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament
- b) Fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she may receive zero ranking points for the tournament
- c) If zero points are awarded the points will count as one of the players 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically
- d) Commits either of these offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Juniors Circuit for a period of 12 months

Data protection & Privacy policy:

The team will be publishing draws, results, photos of players as well as live footage from matches, players and the venue. As this is part of the tournament regulations, SBN will deem that players/managers/coaches have accepted these regulations by entering the tournament.

CLOSING DATE

- **Closing date is the 5th of April 2026 for all the packages.**

DRAWS

The seeding and times of first matches will be published on the tournament website. The finalized draws will be published at the venue and on the website at the start of the event.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is € 109,- includes, physiotherapy, tournament gift and service and handling fee. Prices For hotel packages see next page.

Only entries who have completed their registration including payment will be entered to the tournament. If you don't complete the online entry fully then you won't be entered to the tournament.

To complete the registration players must fill in all the information tabs in the online registration form. MNA's will receive an excel file after their registration for all the additional information needed.

CANCELLATIONS

The costs for hotel packages cannot be refunded for any cancellations received on or after **5th of May 2026**. For cancellations between **5th of April and 5th of May 2026**, only a 50% refund will be made (less all bank charges). Any refunds will be made after the tournament.

FORCE MAJEURE

The players are obliged to follow the rules of the Dutch Government when it comes to travelling to the Netherlands, leaving the Netherlands and during the event. Squash Bond Nederland is not responsible and can't be held accountable for any possible additional costs. Squash Bond Nederland can't not be held accountable for any late cancellations (such as COVID-19) or force majeure.

VISA APPLICATION

If players need to apply for a visa, they can apply for a confirmation letter from the Dutch Junior Open. Players can acquire a confirmation letter on request.

Please take the following guidelines in to account when visas are needed:

- Before applying for a letter player must register for entry of the Dutch Junior Open 2026.
- Before a letter is sent payment must have been received.
- Before a letter is sent the organization must receive the following necessary information:

- Receiving a letter from the Dutch Junior Open can take up to 5 working days after registration, payment and necessary information are received.

- Acquiring the visa is the responsibility of the players. If the visa gets denied after the entry deadline players will only be able to get a refund according to the rules for cancellations as written above.

HOTELROOM BOOKINGS

- **HOTELROOM SHARING**
 - The organization is free to put players without a sharing partner together.
 - The organization cannot put players together with more than 1 age category difference.
 - The organization cannot put players together of a different gender.
 - The sharing of rooms is the responsibility of a coach or parent. The organization cannot be held responsible for any problems.
- **ODD NUMBER OF ENTRY'S**
 - If a national federation or group of players enters an odd number of players for multiple rooms, then the organization must put 1 player in a single room. Or share with another player regarding the hotel sharing regulations as written above.
 - If there is no other player to share with, then the organization is free to charge the national federation or player for the upgrade to a single room.
- **DIFFERENCE IN ARRIVAL DATES**
 - The arrival and departure date of the players 2 players shared must be the same. If one player has a different arrival or departure date, then this player must book a single room.

Be on time for your hotel room, full = full!

TRANSPORT

The Van der Valk Hotel provides free shuttle service from Schiphol Airport to the Hotel. There is another free shuttle bus that goes to the squash venue and the hotel during the tournament (Starting at Thursday). A timetable will be displayed at the squash center, at the hotel and on the tournament website.
